

IHBC February Winter Hike on Sunday, 26th February

Hiking in the hills of Hármashater



The first IHBC hike of the year will be around the lovely wintery hills of Hármashater. Suitable for all (including children), the type of walk will be planned on the day; it will depend on the numbers, including parents with children. The hike will be between 10 and 15k taking around three hours to complete, if the turnout is as high as we hope. We have two options extreme or casual hiking – both finishing at the same time.

We will meet promptly at Széll Kálmán tér at 11:00

Departing from Széll Kálmán tér on the No. 56 tram at 11:15am to Hüvosvölggy Way tram stop. From here we will hike through the Hármashater hills and hopefully finish up on the other side of Hármashater-hegy around 3pm at the family-run restaurant www.fenyogyongye.hu for a well-deserved Hungarian winter meal.

After the meal, we can take the bus back down the hill to the bus stop near McDonalds and from there back to the city. Please take note that you will need three (3) bus tickets starting from Széll Kálmán: one to get to the starting point and two to get home from the restaurant.

What to wear and what to bring (please take note of the weather the night before)

- Good walking boots
- Warm clothing
- Water, flask of hot drink
- Snacks, energy bars, sandwiches, etc.
